Important reminders

- Students must complete 9 (50 minute) in-person and remote synchronous classes to pass a course in Quarters 1, 2, 3, 4 and Summer.

- No more than 1 make-up can be completed per day.
- All make-ups must be completed and submitted to the instructor by the last class within the same quarter unless registered for a remote make- up option.
- Students are eligible to complete 2 make-ups per course, per quarter (not applicable for Extreme PE and Asynchronous courses)
- Students must be prepared to show MIT ID to make-up instructor.
